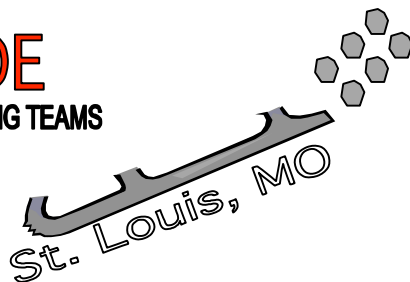

The "Friends of South County Skaters" and the staff of the Wayne C. Kennedy Recreation Complex extend an invitation to you to participate in the 23rd Annual Sweetheart Open District 9 Championships, February 10-12, 2012, at the Wayne C. Kennedy Recreation Complex, 6050 Wells Road, St. Louis, Missouri.

The competition is endorsed by the **ISI Endorsement # 3-1407-2011** and is open to all current individual members of the ISI. ISI members who are also members of the USFSA are eligible to compete per the ISI/USFSA joint statement of policy. (For a list of test levels at which USFSA skaters may compete, see the new *2012 Edition of the ISI Handbook*.) Skaters may compete only at their highest test levels passed and registered with the ISI by **February 1, 2012**.

The competition is open to skaters of all ages and will consist of the following events: Tots 1-4, Pre-Alpha thru Delta; Freestyle 1-10; Open Freestyle – Bronze-Platinum; Special Skater; Solo Compulsories Tots -FS10; Spins, Artistic 1-10; Interpretive 1-10; Footwork 1-10; Solo Dance 1-10; Stroking Pre-Alpha thru Delta; Spotlight Solo and Couple: Character, Dramatic or Light Entertainment; Family Spotlight; Jump and Spin Teams; Team Compulsories; Synchronized Skating Compulsories; Synchronized Formation, Synchronized Skating; Synchronized Dance; Synchronized Open; Collegiate Synchronized Team; Ensemble; Kaliedoskate; Pattern; and Production.

We reserve the right to divide the age groups according to the entries received.

Entry Forms and Fees

Individual entries are \$40.00 for the first event and \$15.00 for each additional event. Family entries are \$70.00 per family which covers the first event for 2 or more skaters in the family and \$15.00 each for additional events. Team Compulsories, Synchronized Teams, Ensemble, Production Numbers, and Family Spotlight are \$20.00 per skater per event.

Entries must be postmarked by **January 6, 2012**. **All** entries postmarked after January 6th, will be charged a \$25.00 late fee and will be accepted at the discretion of the Competition Director. There will be a \$25.00 charge for any returned check. We reserve the right to limit the number of entries and to refuse late entries.

There will be **NO REFUNDS**.

Competitor Registration

All skaters must register and pick up their Competitor's Packets at the registration table. All competitors should arrive at the rink at least 1 hour before the scheduled time of their event. The schedule of events will be sent to the rink two weeks prior to the competition. Dressing rooms will be provided for the skaters' convenience.

Rules

The competition will be conducted in accordance with the guidelines contained in the **2012 ISI Handbook along with all 2012 Rule Revisions**. All effective rule changes from the ISI will be upheld.

Music

All music must be on CD's clearly labeled on the correct side with the skater's name, level, age, sex, and team name. Music must be turned in at the Registration Desk no later than one hour prior to the scheduled time of the event. All CDs should be picked up by the conclusion of each day. Please bring back-up copies of all music. We will not be responsible for music that is left at the rink after the competition has concluded.

Awards

Medals will be awarded for First thru Fifth places. Members of placing Synchro teams will receive medals plus their team will receive a trophy. Trophies will be presented for the First and Second place rink teams. A Percentage trophy will also be awarded.

Competition Scoring

Individual skater scores will not be posted - only the names of skaters earning first thru fifth places. When there is only one skater in an event, the skater must receive 80 percent of the total possible score to receive first place. All other skaters against the book will receive 2nd Place. Team points for individual & partner events will receive 1 participation point plus the placement points as follows: First Place - 5 points, Second Place - 4 points, Third Place - 3 points, Fourth Place - 2 points and Fifth Place - 1 point. The following team events - Synchronized Teams, Team Compulsories, Ensemble and Production will receive 5 participation points plus the placement points as follows: First Place – 25 points, Second Place – 20 points, Third Place – 15 points, Fourth Place – 10 points, and Fifth Place – 5 points.

Synchronized Teams

Synchronized teams (Dance, Formation and Skating) must contain a minimum of 8 skaters up to a maximum of 24 skaters. Every team member's name, age, and ISI Individual Membership number must be listed on the entry form. For Synchronized Teams **ONLY** – skaters' ages are as of July 1, 2011. Synchronized teams are requested to send one check for each team entry.

Facility

The Wayne C. Kennedy Recreation Complex ice rink measures 85'x200', with spectator seating for 600 and ample parking. Dressing rooms are available. A snack bar serving a variety of foods is in the lobby and a variety of restaurants are located within a 10-minute drive of the rink.

Coaches and Judges Requirements

Each team should provide one judge for every 10 events entered in the competition. Please submit judges' inquiry forms, signed by each judge, with your competitors' entry forms. Coaches will be required to give their time as judges to obtain access to the arena entry area and the hospitality room. All coaches who are not qualified to judge but would like access to the rink side area will be required to pay a fee of \$25 or volunteer in another area of the competition for 1 hour. Coaches will not be allowed by the ice with their skaters if they do not fulfill their judging requirements or make the required donation.

PERFORMANCE RULES

Team Points raised for all ISI competitions as follows:

The following group event entries will receive:

1. First Place - 25 points
2. Second Place - 20 points
3. Third Place - 15 points
4. Fourth Place - 10 points
5. Fifth Place - 5 points

Group events: Pattern, Production, Synchronized Teams, Kaleidoskate, and Team Compulsories

SPINS EVENT

The Spins event will have the same rules as the Compulsories events but the skaters will be assigned only spin elements from the appropriate levels. Levels will be divided into Beginner (FS 1-3), Beginner High (FS 4-5), Intermediate (Freestyle 6-8) and Advanced (FS 9-10).

Spins

Selected spins can be skated in ANY order and additional maneuvers, such as jumps, spins, or gliding maneuvers from a test level or any uncaptured move are not allowed.

Beginner (Freestyle 1-3)

Forward Pivot, 2 Foot Spin & Backward Pivot

Beginner High (Freestyle 4-5)

Forward Scratch Spin, Camel Spin, & Fast Back Scratch Spin

Intermediate (Freestyle 6-8)

Layback Spin, Sit – Back Sit Combination, & Spin Combination with one change of foot and at least 3 body positions

Advanced (Freestyle 9-10)

Flying Spin, Camel-Change Camel, Spin Combination with minimum 1 change of foot and at least 3 body positions.

JUMP AND SPIN TEAMS

Skaters must choose one spin and one jump to be performed.

Low	Both skaters must be in Pre-Alpha to Delta levels ONLY.
Medium	Both skaters must be in Freestyle 1-3 levels or below.
Intermediate	Both skaters must be in Freestyle 4-5 levels or below.
High	Both skaters must be in Freestyle 6-10 levels or below.

LOW Jump – 2-Foot Hop or Bunny Hop Jump – 2-Foot Spin

MEDIUM Jump - ½ Flip or Toe Loop Jump – 2-Foot or 1-Foot Spin

INTERMEDIATE Jump - ½ Loop or Axel Jump – Sit Spin or Back Spin

HIGH Jump – Dbl. Salchow or Dbl. Loop Jump – Flying Camel or Flying Sit Spin

SOLO COMPULSORY MANEUVERS (Maneuvers will match those selected for 2012 ISI National Events)

Selected maneuvers can be skated in ANY order and additional maneuvers, such as jumps, spins, or gliding maneuvers from a test level or any uncaptured move are not allowed.

NOTE: There is no penalty for the quantity of swizzles, wiggles, strokes or crossovers performed in the Tot-Beta levels. Only the quality of these maneuvers is judged.

2012 ISI TEST & COMPETITION RULE REVISIONS (Updated 9/12/11)

The following 2012 Synchronized Competition Revisions are mandatory for all competitions after September 1, 2011. Competition Directors should inform all participants and judges before their event.

1. Synchronized Competition Event Revisions & Clarifications:

- Synchronized Skating Teams in both the Teen **and Senior Youth age divisions** can now perform any spin(s).
- Synchronized Formation Teams **can perform 2-foot spins in any age division**.
- Synchronized team skaters are now limited to compete at **one age division lower than their true age division** (for example, a 12-year old Sr. Youth team skater can skate on a Youth team, but not on a Jr. Youth team). **Skaters can compete in any higher age division category***. All age divisions still require a **MAJORITY** of skaters – but not every skater – to fit within the age division for that team.
***Note – This is a revised change in wording from previous printed versions of these Rule Revisions.**

2. New Synchronized Events:

- **NEW! Synchronized Skating Open Competition Event:** This event for Sr. Youth, Teen, Collegiate and Adult age divisions only will consist of a 4:00 minute program with no required elements. The program restrictions for traditional skating team events must be followed. The judging criteria will be: Technical Merit, Correctness, Choreography & Pattern, Music Interpretation, Unison, Duration and General Overall.
- **NEW! Advanced Formation Synchronized Event:** This new team category for skaters who are continuing to master the basics of good synchronized skating such as straight lines, correct holds and unison. The program must include at least one of each of the following basic elements: Line, Circle, Block, Wheel and Intersection. Skaters are permitted to skate backwards on one foot but are limited to using only 3-turns and mohawks for turning and in footwork sequences.
- **NEW! Collegiate Age Group for All Synchronized Team Events:** The majority of skaters must be ages 18-25, and the team members must be affiliated with the college/university that they are representing.

The following 2012 Test & Competition Revisions are optional for ISI competitions from September 1, 2011 and mandatory for all events after January 1, 2012. Competition Directors must inform all participants and judges if they will follow these new revisions for competition events from September 1 – December 31, 2011.

3. Competition Event Revisions & Clarifications:

- **Open Freestyle events** – Skaters can now perform **any spin at any level**. The current jump limitations remain in effect for the Bronze, Silver & Gold levels. The Open Freestyle test maneuver choices remain the same.
- **Competition Dance events** – As long as the skater has passed the individual ISI dance test, **they can compete that dance in competition events** (i.e. Solo, Similar, Mixed or Pro Partner). The skater **is no longer required to complete all dances** in the higher dance test level to compete any dance(s) at that higher level.
- **Rhythmic Skating Ribbon & Hoop Prop Clarification** – The ribbon streamer must be **one single streamer** piece (not multiple streamers) according to the prop guidelines in the *ISI Handbook*. The hoop can have colored tape or fabric to match the skater's costume, but it **cannot have any other decoration** (i.e. fringe, etc.) on the prop.

If multiple ribbon streamers or fringe is used on the hoop, those programs should be entered into the Spotlight Light Entertainment category and not in the Rhythmic Skating events.

4. Judging Revisions & Clarifications:

- **Solo Compulsory events judging criteria** – The “**General Overall**” criteria will be added to the **Judge 1 (Referee) sheet only**. Any penalties such as the 2.0 score for attempting illegal maneuvers or taking two attempts at the required maneuvers will be assessed by Judge 1 (Referee).
- **Open Freestyle events judging criteria** – The current “**Correctness**” criteria on the Judge 1 (Referee) sheet will be changed to “**Correctness of Jumps**”. The new criteria for Judge 2 will be “**Correctness of Spins**”. The new criteria for Judge 3 will be “**Correctness of Turns and Edges**”. As a reminder, **difficulty of maneuvers is not considered under any Correctness score** – only the technical accuracy of the maneuvers performed will be comparatively judged.

5. Created Events & New Events:

- **Created Events for Local or District Competitions** (events not defined in the *ISI Handbook*) – Any created event requiring a technical (freestyle-type) program must be approved by the Test & Competition Standards Committee prior to being offered at any local or district competition. **New created event submissions must be made by April 1st** for consideration at the annual committee meeting in May.

Created events that do not require a technical program (i.e. longest spin, shoot-the-duck or spiral, etc.) must be submitted with the competition endorsement application for approval **at least 90 days prior to the event date – and prior to any announcement or publication of the created event(s)**.

- **NEW! Theater Production Event:** This category is for your entire skating team. Skaters of all ages and advanced ability level can participate in this new theatrical team event. This is a creative, artistic program based on story or theme, using costumes, props and technical skating to enhance the performance quality. Program length is 6:30; however, there is no penalty for shorter program times.
- **NEW! Open Pair Tests & Events:** Please refer to the new *2012 ISI Handbook* for complete test requirements and descriptions.

Bronze Pair Test & Competition Event Requirements: Any two jumps, spins, and lifts from Pair 1-3 test levels; one arabesque or undercut spiral; a sequence of crossovers and/or cutbacks. Program length: 2 minutes.

Silver Pair Test & Competition Event Requirements: Any two jumps and spins, from Pair 4-5 test levels; one pair spiral; two lifts from Pair 5 or below; the dance step sequence from Pair 5 or a sequence of your own design. Program length: 3 minutes.

Gold Pair Test & Competition Event Requirements: Any two jumps and spins from Pair 5-6 test levels; one spiral or death spiral from any level; two lifts from Pair 6 or below; the dance step sequence from Pair 5 or 6 or a sequence of your own design. Program length: 3 minutes.

Platinum Pair Test & Competition Event Requirements: Any two jumps, jump combinations or throws; any two spins and two lifts from Pair 7-10 levels; a spiral sequence of the skaters own design; the dance step sequence from Pair 7-10 test levels or a sequence of your own design. Program length: 4:30 minutes.

- **NEW! Adult Champs Trophies:** Both the Erika Amundsen Trophy (awarded to the overall Adult Team Champions) **and the new Collegiate Champion Trophy** will be presented at the annual ISI Adult Championships event.
